

Amateur Test Sessions

The Brunswick Shores Amateur Radio Club offers Test Sessions for Technician, General and Extra class licenses. Dates and location are listed on the Club Calendar. All test sessions are now given online. You will still come to the test facility (location) where you will sit at a terminal or computer to take the test. Overall it is a much faster system.

What you need to do BEFORE the exam:

1. FCC Registration Number (FRN) <https://apps.fcc.gov/cores/userLogin.do>
 - o If you already have a license, you have an FRN.
 - o Otherwise REGISTER (use your email address when you register)
2. Register with Hamstudy.org <https://hamstudy.org/register>
 - o This is FREE and only required to obtain a PIN.
 - o This site is also great for preparing for the exam.
3. Log in to Examtools.org <https://examtools.org/>
 - o This is where you need the PIN obtained from Hamstudy.org
 - o You should find our test sessions listed under N4GM.
 - o This is where you register for the exam.
4. Send an email to EXAMS@n4gm.org with the test session date, your contact information and any questions.

What you need THE DAY of the exam

1. Valid PHOTO ID (Drivers License etc.)
2. \$12 Cash or check
3. Copy of your current Amateur License (if any)
4. Copy of any CSCE (if any)
 - o (Certificate of Successful Completion of Exam)
 - o This would apply if you had passed an exam but not received your license yet.
 - o This would have been given to you at your previous exam session.
