Notice:

- We will have a quick exercise this week.
- I will be asking you to send me a copy of the ICS 214a that you have kept for the month of January stating the time you have spent working on the Winlink exercise(s) you have completed for me.
- I will ask you to complete an ICS 309 (as complete as you can) within Winlink of the Winlink communication you have had with me K1MJJ for the month of January.
- You should have the two documents that I sent to you explaining how to create an ICS 309 document within Winlink and the document explaining how we will use an ICS 214a.
 - If you don't have either or both documents, then send me an email and I will provide them to you.
 - You should also have a writable ICS 214a PDF that I sent to you. If you don't then send me an email and I will send you a copy.

Your Task:

- Create and send a Winlink Quick message with your ICS 214 and ICS 309 forms attached to the Winlink Quick message.

Steps to complete this exercise:

1. Create a new message and click on "Select Template"
2. Expand Standard Forms → Expand General Forms → Select Quick Message.txt
3. Send to address: K1MJJ
4. Add an SMS number: Leave it blank
5. Carrier: Leave it blank
6. Don't click the button "Click to add SMS phone"
7. From: Your name and call sign

8. Date/Time: Click the box and accept the current date and time.
9. Subject: Sending ICS 214a & ICS 309
10. Message:
 - a. Write your Call sign, your name, your city or town, your County, the method of sending the Winlink message
 - i. Such as Telnet, Packet, Vara HF, Vara FM
 - b. On the next line write your latitude and longitude.
11. Check your work and when you are satisfied press the Submit button
12. Back at the new Message window click the Attach button
 - a. Attach your ICS 214a document and attach your ICS 309 document
13. Post the message to the Outbox and send your message to me.

Have fun and learn from this exercise.
