  - I have sent all of you a document on how to create a personal folder within Winlink
- You should have the two documents that I sent to you explaining how to create an ICS 309 document within Winlink and the document explaining how we will use an ICS 214a.
  - If you don't have either or both documents, then send me an email and I will provide them to you.

You should also have a blank writable ICS 214a PDF that I sent to you. If you don't, then send me an email and I will send you a copy.

### The Scenario:

- This exercise will deal with the ICS 205 Incident Radio Communications Plan.
- The ICS 205 is usually written by an Emergency Communicator (EC) for an event but you as a Volunteer should be able to read and comprehend what this form is all about because you will receive one from the EC for that event you are participating in.
- I will provide you with the information to fill in the ICS 205.

- Note: For an event you will receive this information, and you will need to use the information to program your radio for the event.

### Steps to complete this exercise:

1. Create a new message.
2. Select the template Field Situation Report.txt
  - a. Standard Forms → ICS USA Forms → ICS205 Radio Plan.txt
3. Setup button: “Brunswick County EmComm Winlink Net”
