Notice:

- Please maintain your monthly ICS 214a for the month of October stating the time you spend working on the Winlink exercise(s) you have completed for the month of October. I will ask for the 214a at the end of the month.
- Please keep all Winlink correspondence for the month of October exercises in a separate folder within Winlink. If you do so, then it will be straightforward to collect them in an ICS 309 communication log to send to me at the end of the month.
 - I have sent all of you a document on how to create a personal folder within Winlink
- You should have the two documents that I sent to you explaining how to create an ICS 309 document within Winlink and the document explaining how we will use an ICS 214a.
 - If you don't have either or both documents, then send me an email and I will provide them to you.

You should also have a blank writable ICS 214a PDF that I sent to you. If you don't, then send me an email and I will send you a copy.

Note:

- I would recommend that you send me your ICS 214a and ICS 309 via Telnet. PDF files created the way I have asked you to create them are quite large. If you try to send them via VHF or HF then you will be sending them through a slower medium.

The Scenario:

- For this exercise, we are going back to an exercise we did in July. We are currently involved with a hurricane called Balboa.
- As a reminder of that last exercise involving hurricane Balboa, you will recall that the hurricane is a category 2 hurricane that is affecting our area with heavy winds and lots of rain.
- We are experiencing power outages, Internet service outages, road closures, trees are down and multiple auto accidents from people attempting to drive under these bad conditions. • The county has initiated Level 2, and the Emergency Management Director is asking for Volunteers to man the EOCs in the county.
- He is assigning one of the volunteers to the Brunswick County Hospital (fictitious name). Guess what, you have been assigned to that hospital.
- The EOC is asking for bed counting at the hospital.
- The Logistics Department at the Hospital under Timothy Jones has supplied that information to you.
- **The objective for this exercise is to familiarize yourself with another of the forms you may have to use if you do have to report to a hospital under these circumstances.**

Steps to complete this exercise:

1. Open a new message.
2. Select template Hospital Bed Report.txt
 - a. Standard Forms → General Medical Forms → Hospital Bed Report.txt
3. Click on Form Info at the top right-hand side of the form to familiarize yourself with the form.
4. Click on the Setup button and type “Brunswick County EmComm Winlink Net”.
5. Check the box “This is an Exercise”
6. Click the box for “Report Date/Time”
7. Name of the Reporting Facility is Brunswick County Hospital
8. Street Address is 240 Hospital Drive
9. City is Bolivia.
10. State is NC.
11. Zip Code is 28422.
